Vocabulary:

Communion: from the Latin “communio” meaning sharing together

Consecration: to make Holy. In the Mass it refers to the moment when the bread and wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ.

Covenant-sacred promise between a person and God.

Eucharist-means thanksgiving. Also called the Last Supper.

Sacrifice-A ritual offering made to God by a priest. A sign of adoration, thanksgiving, being humble, and communion.

Tabernacle-a vessel (container) in the church where the consecrated Eucharist is kept.

Transubstantiation- “to change the substance” when the bread and wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ.

Victim-for Christians, Jesus is the ultimate sacrificial victim, he offered himself to free the world from sin.
